



McGill Bird Observatory Internships 2006

The McGill Bird Observatory (MBO) is seeking 3 interns for the month of August to assist in bird-banding operations. Interns are taught a variety of field skills, including the safe extraction of birds from mist-nets, identification of difficult species, and how to age and sex individuals. Interns also participate in other banding station activities, including site maintenance. Interns do not need prior banding experience, but some familiarity with identification of eastern North American birds is preferred. Accommodations are available at McGill University at the cost of about 300\$/month. Applications must be received before April 15th.
